Ecotrust Launches Site that Links Food Buyers and Farmers

PORTLAND, OR – Ecotrust rolled out a long-awaited program that will hook up Oregon farmers, fishermen or food manufacturers with commercial buyers, from a single chef to the institutional head looking for local products to stock a school system's kitchens.

The FoodHub program, which I wrote about in 2008, isn't free — \$100 for growers and buyers. But folks who sign up before Jan. 31 receive a \$20 rebate.
