BEND, OR – An online marketplace for buyers and sellers of Oregon agriculture is celebrating its first anniversary with plans to expand. The FoodHub is a virtual wholesale location, and Gary Roth with the Oregon Department of Agriculture said after one year, things are looking good.

"FoodHub has continued to capture the interest of many in the community, both those who are food producers and food buyers, as we thought it would."

Roth said small and large producers are using the site, while catering to a diverse set of buyers, ranging from food processors and farmers' markets to chefs and school.
